# A Look Ahead to the New Season

First, I would like to wish you a Happy New Year! I wish you joy and peace and a lot of fun on the water. Let me tell you about some of the exiting events and changes you can expect for 2014.

#### No Increase in Fees for 2014

We are happy to report that the Chicago Park District held rates at the harbors constant for the second year in a row and has reduced rates for some slips at 31<sup>st</sup> Street as well.

# **New Floating Music Festival**

Last June, like many of you, I thoroughly enjoyed being in Burnham Harbor on the night of Jimmy Buffett's concert. I have never seen so many parties and so many boaters have a good time. It gave us an idea; a music festival in the south end of 31<sup>st</sup> Street Harbor in August. We'll give you more information in May when you check into your harbor.

# **Enhanced WiFi in the Harbors**

Five years ago, we installed a free WiFi system in the harbors. At the time, the system served things like email, surfing the web and on-line chat. Then, along came Netflix, HuLu and other web-based video-streaming providers. Since 2010, the usage of the system has increased hundreds of times! For those of you who have had difficulty connecting to the system, this is why. To keep up with the dramatically increased usage, we are installing an enhanced system that will be able to deliver more than 100 times as much bandwidth as the current system. To make this possible, we are installing a new fiber-optic backbone in the harbors and replacing the existing transmitting equipment. It is an expensive project, but one that Westrec and the Chicago Park District know you will like. I'm happy to report that we are keeping the system FREE to harbor users. Look for completion in early summer.

# **Low Water Levels, Dredging and Breakwaters**

According to the US Army Corps of Engineers, our current lake levels are 13" higher than they were a year ago and the 6-month forecast calls for water levels similar to or higher than those of 2013. That is GOOD NEWS! That said, we still are experiencing water levels that are more than a foot lower than the historical average, as we have for the past 14 years. The harbor that is most affected by this is Jackson Outer Harbor. As a result, we have engaged engineers to design a breakwater to prevent (or at least considerably reduce) the sedimentation of the harbor entrance. We expect to be able to show the plans for the breakwater and enhanced dredging to the boating community in January and February.

As you can tell, we have a lot to keep us busy this winter. We look forward to seeing you in May and on the water this summer!

# **Winter Storage and Annual Contracts**

For the upcoming season we are revising our incentives offered to some harbors last year as well as introducing an incentive for other harbors. In 2014 we will be offering annual contracts for combined summer mooring and winter storage in place of last year's incentives.

The annual contract allows customers who keep their boat in the Chicago Harbors to make three payments from February to July. Furthermore, 31<sup>st</sup> Street, 59<sup>th</sup> Street, Jackson Park Inner and Jackson Park Outer boaters can receive a 15% discount while Montrose, Belmont, Diversey, DuSable, Monroe and Burnham boaters can receive a 5% discount. The discount is applied to both the winter storage fee and your base mooring fee.

If you are interested, please fill out the form included with your invoice and return it by February 7th. We will send you further information with your specific payment schedule within two business days.

# **Marine Sanitation Inspections**

In 2014 we will be continuing the Marine Sanitation Inspection procedures introduced last year. Most boaters who have been inspected in 2011, 2012 or 2013, have a completed inspection form on file and have not made any changes to the sanitation system since that report, will only have to complete an affidavit attesting to that.

Any other boaters, customers with a different boat in 2014 along with all new boaters and commercial permittees will need to have a Marine Sanitation Inspection performed by either authorized harbor personnel or by an approved boat yard.

We will again provide inspections by harbor

personnel at no charge. To schedule an inspection, contact your harbor office or email us at *inspections@westrecchicago.com* to schedule your inspection. Though there may be certified harbor personnel available who can do inspections on short notice, we recommend making your sanitation inspection appointment at least three days in advance.
